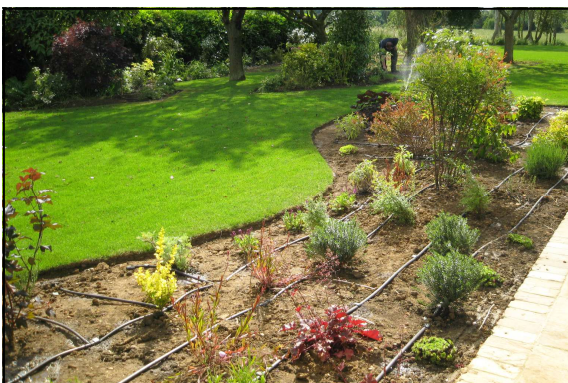

Description

The DIY landscape kits allow the keen gardener to install an irrigation system using professional quality parts at a much lower cost than a bespoke system. Access Irrigation provide systems for large and prestigious projects and use exactly the same high quality components in the DIY kits.

Kits are available for watering borders with either sprinklers or drip lines. Lawns can be watered using pop-up sprinklers with all of the supply pipework buried under the lawn. Valve boxes control the individual watering zones and are controlled by sophisticated battery operated controllers. With kits for lawns, borders and valve boxes it is easy to create a fully automated weather sensitive system.

Lawn Sprinklers

Lawn watering kits hide all of the pipework and fittings underground for neatness. Kits connect directly to the valve box.

Code: [SLW2](#) or [SLW3](#)

Water Regulations generally require a break tank and pump for lawn sprinklers. Refer to your water supplier.

Valve Box

Buried in the lawn, contains valves for each zone. 1 separate controller will turn these on and off. 2 zone or 4 zone valve boxes available.

Code: [EPAV02](#) or [EPAV04](#)

Optional DB valve kit available for compliance with Water Regulations on dripline systems

Controllers

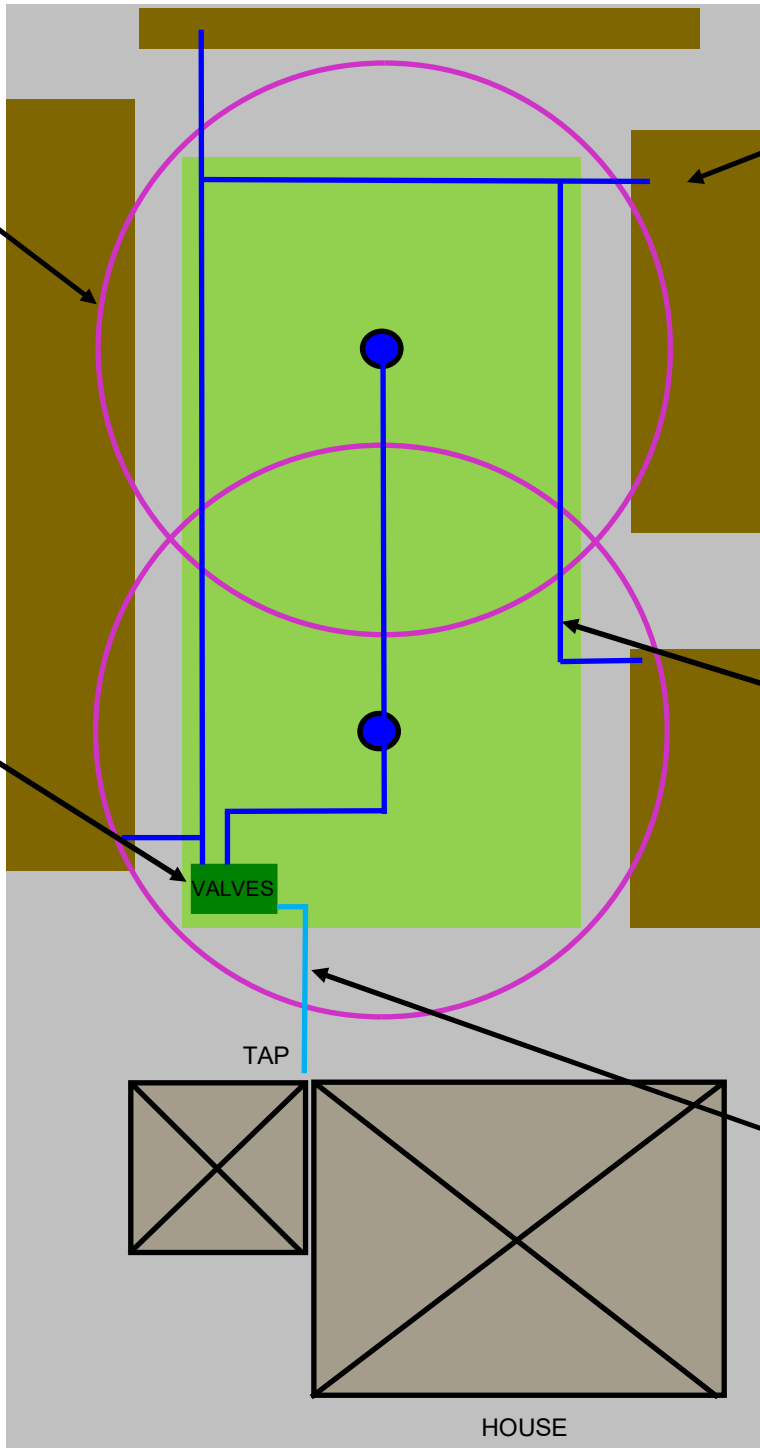
Battery operated controllers are easy to install and a set of batteries will last the whole season.

Galcon models are waterproof. Suitable for up to 4 zones they drop into the valve box

Code: [EPAGDC4](#)

Hunter XC outdoor controller is wall mounted and will control 6 or 12 zones. Optional rain sensor to prevent watering in wet weather.

Border Watering

Drip or sprinkler kits are available.

Drip kits are more water efficient and allow bigger areas to be watered. DB valve required to comply with the Water Regulations.

Sprinkler kits are easier to install on established beds. Sprinklers cover bed widths between 1m and 3m

Border link kits

Underground pipe allows up to 4 separate borders to be connected to the valve box (or directly to an outside tap) to make a single watering zone. Suitable for drip or sprinkler kits.

Code: [SLK4](#)

Tap Link Kit

Allows connection from an outside tap to the valve box. 10m of pipe and fittings included. Optional signal cable kit if wall mounted controller is used.

Code: [STK20](#)

Optional DB valve kit available for compliance with Water Regulations on dripline systems (requires XC controller)

Water Pressure

It is a good idea to check you have enough water flow and pressure available before you purchase. We sell a pressure test kit to allow you to test your supply.

Code: [EPTTEST](#)

If your water supply is insufficient then we can supply a break tank and booster pump. This will also provide Water Regulation compliance for pop-up sprinklers.
